USE OF COLLEGE FACILITIES

Colleges of the Contra Costa Community College District, as community institutions, are oriented to the educational, cultural and recreational needs of all citizens of the College District, and the Governing Board and administration encourage the use of all facilities when they are not required to carry on the programs of the colleges.

The use of District facilities by community nonprofit organizations and public agencies shall be granted under the provisions of the Civic Center Act in accordance with the policy. The use of District facilities by private groups and religious groups for religious purposes may also be granted.

PROPERTY MANAGEMENT

The Chancellor or designee is delegated the authority to act as the Board's negotiator regarding all property management matters that are necessary for the benefit of the District. No transaction regarding the lease, sale, or exchange of real property by the District shall be enforceable until acted on by the Board itself.

The Chancellor shall establish such procedures as may be necessary to assure compliance with all applicable laws relating to the sale, lease, use, rental or exchange of real property by the District.
