GRATUITIES: TIPPING/FOOD PRODUCTS

Culinary Program and Student Employees

Gratuities in the form of tipping, free meals, food or discounted food shall not be accepted by student employees or students involved in the college Food Service Program or Culinary Program. A notice to this effect shall be posted in conspicuous locations informing patrons of this policy. In the event tipping gratuities are made, they shall be forwarded to the college business office for deposit to the Cafeteria Fund (Fund 52) as miscellaneous revenue (object code 48890).

Food Service Employees

Gratuities in the form of tipping shall not be accepted by employees in the college Food Service Program. In the event tipping gratuities are made, they shall be forwarded to the college business office for deposit to the Cafeteria Fund (Fund 52) as miscellaneous revenue (object code 48890). In addition, under no circumstances shall compensation, defined in Internal Revenue Code 119, in the form of free meals, food or discounted food be made available to food service employees, regardless of the number of hours or shifts worked in the Food Service Program.
