## **UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE EXEMPTION FOR STUDENT EMPLOYEES**

Student employees are not covered by unemployment insurance. Section 642 of the California Unemployment Insurance Code indicates, "employment does not include service performed in the employ of a school, college, or university if such service is performed: a) by a student who is enrolled and is regularly attending such school, college, or university."

Section 642(a)(1) of Title 22 (Employment Development Department) indicates, "a student is "regularly attending classes" when he/she meets the minimum attendance requirement for his/her course of study established by the school, college, or university."
