### DEFINITION

To install and maintain custom and commercial programs, web services, and databases to meet the changing needs of the user community.

### SUPERVISION RECEIVED AND EXERCISED

- Receives supervision from a departmental supervisor or manager.

- May provide training and direction to student assistants or other assigned staff.

- Performs installation and maintains applications and databases according to requirements using current development tools.
- Designs and develops basic programs and scripts.
- Queries and exports data from District information system and imports into local applications.
- Runs custom reports from databases as requested.
- Creates and executes tests for new and updated applications to ensure compatibility and functionality.
- Creates user accounts for applications.
- Maintains and updates websites and back-end databases.
- Ensures applications and data are updated and secure.
- Troubleshoots and serves as a technical resource to users and colleagues.
- Provides user support and training.
- Routinely produces and maintains application and database documentation.
- Works with other teams throughout the department and interacts with the user community to determine the feasibility, requirements, and technical design of assigned projects.
- Performs related duties as assigned.

### MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Knowledge of:

- Current web standards and technology, including HTML, CSS, software development tools, programming/scripting languages, program logic, Web Server software and NET framework.
- Industry standard developer tools for building network applications (TCP/IP).
- Relational database concepts and Structured Query Language (SQL).
- Web servers and applications.
- Software design, lifecycle and quality assurance principles.
- Systems analysis.
- Web server applications and operating systems.
- Standard business English, grammar and spelling.
