




\*Because of its size, Clayton Valley is the only charter school included in this study.







High School Graduate Capture Trend




#### Number of 2021-2022 High School Graduates from County Districts Attending 4CD in 2022-2023




#### 2022-23 Overall Course Success Rates at 4CD by High School District




## 2022-23 English Course Success Rates at 4CD by High School District
